Six years ago, Haley House Bakery Cafe opened its doors in Dudley Square, offering healthy food at affordable prices and a great place to gather. Almost immediately our customers asked us to cater their events - the beginning of our catering division, providing an unseen revenue stream and source of new jobs.

Soon, Officer Bill Baxter asked if we were interested in working with him on his gang resistance cooking classes, which have developed into our *Take Back the Kitchen* curriculum. Nina LaNegra approached us with the idea of a performance series, which has become *Art is Life itself*. The Color of Film Collaborative had the vision for us to host a *Dinner & A Movie*, which has happened quarterly ever since. Discover Roxbury approached us with the idea of *History Nights*, presenting a forum for learning, sharing and conversation about Roxbury's rich history. Thanks to our friends and neighbors, Haley House Bakery Cafe has become so much more.

Since our arrival in Dudley, our training program has developed into the Transitional Employment Program, working exclusively with folks who are still incarcerated, as they prepare to re-enter the community. Their
