A Time for Reflection

Winter offers our Urban Agriculture Team the much needed time to assess the last season and plan for spring. Each year, it becomes more clear that the land has so many lessons to teach us about belonging, connection, and nourishment. Between May and November of 2021, our hardworking farm team harvested thousands of pounds of food, half of which was distributed to our neighbors through the Highland Park Senior Produce distribution program. Another third of the harvests were enjoyed by our local community partners and neighbors, while the rest of the food was put to good use in Haley House's own kitchens. Beyond the harvests, the farm was a space for community to thrive in 2021, especially through weekly family-friendly programming.


